How Hurricane Melissa has affected one of our own

Hurricane Melissa, one of the most powerful Atlantic storms on record, devastated the Caribbean in late October 2025. The storm destroyed homes, knocked out power and cut off access to rural communities.

Even after the hurricane passed, the challenges did not end. Cleanup and rebuilding take weeks or months and many families are left facing unexpected expenses, emotional stress and uncertainty about how to move forward. One of the families affected is closer to home. Our own **Procurement Manager, Fiona Noble**, has been working tirelessly to support her father recovering from this devastation.

Fiona's father lives in Jamaica and was directly impacted by the hurricane. At retirement age, his everyday life was turned upside down in a matter of hours and he is unable to manage the recovery on his own. Basic necessities became hard to access and the damage to his home has completely changed his life.

Fiona has made significant personal sacrifices to support her father, including using her savings, downsizing her car and taking on additional financial responsibilities to ensure he receives the help he needs.

Our Goal: Building a safer future

Our goal is to raise as much money as possible to help fund the construction of a safe, permanent concrete structure for Fiona's father. These are not luxuries, but necessities. A solid concrete build will provide shelter from future storms, restore dignity and create a secure place for him to live as he rebuilds his life after the hurricane.
